Globally, we are coming into a time defined by a fierce escalation of fascist, imperialist and neo-liberal attacks on the lives of people around the world. Hate politics, increased state repression, militarization and a large scale of internal and territorial displacement is the order of the day and lends to other forms of violence.

The magnitude of women's oppression and suffering continues to generate creative and political resistance in the One Billion Rising campaign like we have never seen before. This year OBR is seeing a new, dynamic and radical vibrancy that is opposing and rising against such repression and oppression.

The current political regime that we are living in India is not different in any way from the global political and economic crisis. The current situation in our country can only be described as one of the darkest periods in our independent Indian democracy.

The Delhi high court made a regressive decision when director Mahmood Farooqui was acquitted in a rape case against him by a foreign researcher, based on the judgment of a feeble NO from the woman.

Girl students in Kolhapur Maharashtra have been protesting thousands of incidents of sexual harassment on MSRTC buses. They have been filing cases against bus staff and other boys, and demanding a separate bus for girls.





Girls of Benares Hindu University (BHU) have been protesting and organizing a Liberty Festival after incidents of sexual harassment that were ignored by the Vice Chancellor.



Three employees of Balika Ashram, a government orphanage, in Chamba district, Himachal were arrested for sexually abusing and harassing six minor girls.

OBR friends in Chamba district are planning a survey to check the implementation and running of sexual harassment committees in schools.



24 year old Hadiya was denied the autonomous decision to get married following the Kerala High Court's nullification of her marriage. The court's decision mirrors many Hindu-right wing claims of Love Jihad. Recently, the Kerala Women's Commission reported that Hadiya is living under extreme torture in her family house.

#I Am Gauri- Following the murder of veteran journalist Gauri Lankesh on Sept. 5th, thousands of people have taken a stand against hate politics and violence against women and a stand for rationalism



#Not in My Name- This campaign began after the killing of 15 year old Junaid Khan on a train, bringing together Indians who do not stand for hate politics, the killing of innocent people especially Muslims, Dalits, Adivasis, LGBTQ community, women and many more

#Me Too- This campaign started by veteran feminist Tarana Burke from the US has sparked many debates in India. At the first level it


created a solidarity network

Action Plans for 2018 RISING



The Red Brigade, Lucknow is wrapping up the '100 schools 100 day's program, which included self-defence classes and an introduction to 100 women leaders. For this year's rising, they are planning a gathering of 10,000 girls and self-defense displays.

Development Action Society, Kolkata is planning to work with local SHGs to identify shortcomings in govt. schemes, present their demands to the Corporation Officer on 14th February 2017 and hold a larger forum of women's demands.

The Rajasthan Women's Network is launching its OBR campaign on the 25th of November- the UN day of elimination of violence against women.



NAWO-Odisha is launching with a creative rising on 25th November along with Maya Rao.

Ekta-Madurai is planning to launch on South Asian Women's Day- 30th November.

SRED- Chennai is planning a rising in collaboration with Tamil Nadu Women's Forum and Tamil Nadu Dalit Women's Movement to fight for the most marginalized women and to demand rights.

Given state elections in December, the national OBR secretariat has proposed to the Gujarat OBR network to carry out a women's convention to put forward the charter of demands to political parties based on the Woman's Charter developed through the OBR campaign last year.



This year our RISINGS will be even more creative, collaborative and political.

Creative: The creative, multi-media activities and radical public events with large scale mobilization is integral to the campaign in order to escalate our public presence, strength and voice. ART. Using art forms from storytelling to theatre, poetry and music, dance, monologues, spoken word, song, music, and dance and films as radical calls to action and to escalate political consciousness.

Collaborative:

Collaborative risings are the most effective way to mobilise a large number of people. As a first step, we must organize a state level planning meeting of as many people and organizations. Next, let the national secretariat know about the date of the state level preparatory meetings, the plan of action and the date of the event/ or series of events.

Political: With election due in a number of states in the near future, it is also the time to demand insertion of women's' agenda as a legitimate demand from the contesting candidates, to increase women's' participation in political processes not only at the level of Panchayats but also at the assembly and the parliamentary levels.

This year's student protests in Srinagar following the Pulwama clash of students with security forces took a new turn with many women joining the struggle in the valley. More recently, our J&K partners have condemned the 450 cases of braid chopping



Adivasi and Dalit school girls

Prakriti-Nagpur is rising this year in solidarity with Adivasi and Dalit school girls in Chandrapur who are living in ashram schools (hostels). The rising is to research, advocate and fight for their rights.



Himachal Pradesh state planning meeting

On the 27th of October, 25 people representing 10 organizations from 3 districts of Himachal Pradesh met at Jagori Rural to plan for OBR 2018.

In this meeting it was decided to work on the following :

- 1) To move as a Karvan-e-Mohabbat to various districts to talk against hate politics.
- 2) To work with students of 50 colleges and senior secondary schools on constitutional rights and to focus on working with boys and young men.
- To work along with our experienced friends from Kangra working with Dalit women, we will escalate the demand for women's land rights.
- 4) To carry out a survey in Chamba district on the set-up and implementation of sexual harassment committees in schools.
- 5) To start a social media photography campaign to make friends from another social background called « Selfie nahi, Kisi aur ko jaano »



Intl.Conference Anti-Human trafficking

The Kolkata Mary Ward Social Centre is organising, outside of its OBR plans, this conference on November 25th and 26th 2017. Many international, national as well as regional participants from both Bengal and the North east will be moving together 'from theory to practice'. Subsequent to the conference, an OBR rising in Kolkata's red light district is planned.



V-Day celebrates 20

It has been 20 years since Eve Ensler's play the Vagina Monologues released to shatter boundaries. For this OBR campaign 2018, the texts of both the Vagina Monologues play as well as A Memory, A Monologue, A Rant, A Prayer will be available for those who wish to adapt and stage the shows in February.



Regional & International OBR risings

OBR South Asia Launch in Nepal

On 2nd September 2017, OBR 2018 was launched in Nepal with the attendance of 10 countries. The call was made for Aazaadi for women in South Asia and for an end to the violence caused by the brutal civil war in Nepal.

Bangladesh rises for migrant domestic workers

In a first of its kind event, a Public Hearing for migrant domestic workers will take place in Bangladesh.

Croatia rises with women factory workers

OBR in Croatia launched on the 20th of September 2017, with women workers from the textile factory in Kamensko. These women have been on protest for fair wages, in a situation where privatization has led to the shut-down of many factories.

South Africa rising "Your Child, My Child"

This year's campaign will rise against the killings of many women and children.

Taiwan stages the play Chidi

Taiwan will rise this year with a staging of an adaptation of the Vagina Monologues titled Chidi

Mexico rises on screen

A soap opera on the theme of human trafficking will be launched as part of the OBR 2018 campaign.
